- (b) Additional weightage to be given to those candidates who participated in State / National level sports / games.
- (c) The reservation for SC/ST and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government / State Government, whichever is applicable. There shall be relaxation of 5% marks in favour of SC/ST and other categories of candidates.
- (d) Eligibility criteria for admission to B.P.Ed. 2 years Course :-
- i) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having at least participation in the inter-college Inter-zonal / District / School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

or

ii) Bachelor's degree in Physical education with 45% marks

or

iii) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks and studied physical education as compulsory / elective subject.

or

iv) Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/Inter University / State competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter College / Interzonal / District / School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India

or

v) Bachelor's degree with participation in international competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National/Inter-University competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations / AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

or

vi) Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed in-service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/coaches).

The relaxation in percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the reservtion of seats for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government / State Government, whichever is applicable.

- vii) The candidates should be able to speak, read and write odia and should have had odia as a language subject in the ME Standard or any equivalent, or has been declared to have passed a test in Odia language equivalent to the ME School Standard conducted by the School & Mass Education Department of Govt. of Odisha/BSE, Odisha.
- viii) Candidates appearing in the qualifying examination are also eligible to submit their application for admission into B.P.Ed. 2 years Course subject to submission of their testimonial and mark sheet in original in support of their qualification on or before the date of interview and skill tests fixed by the authority. Failure in submission of such documents shall be tantamount to forfeiture of any claim for admission.

#### Admission procedure

Admission shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the entrance examination (practical test, sports proficiency test, physical fitness test, interview and policy of the State Government.
